Outdoor Day is the newest opportunity for schools in eastern North Carolina. During Outdoor Day students can interact with their environment, develop positive cooperative learning, increase prior knowledge, and have fun.

WHAT: Outdoor Day is an interactive learning experience for 1st – 6th Grade students. What makes Outdoor Day unique is the educational and experiential value of the program. Building on the students need for fun and self discovery, the program will correlate with curriculum guidelines while utilizing experiential learning on an individual and class level. Outdoor Day programs can be utilized by all subjects and will provide a solid point of reference for ongoing lessons and activities once back at school. The activities listed are just a few of the recommended programs to choose from. The Sea Base is always willing to create customized programs based on an individual schools needs.

When: Fall, Spring, and Winter

Where: The Herbert C. Bonner Scout Reservation near Blounts Creek, NC

Who: Outdoor Day activities are ideal for Grades 1 – 6. Programs can also be modified for higher grades as well. Each activity is presented to the class in a manner appropriate to their grade level.

Times: Schedules are flexible for each individual's schools departure/return time at campus.

Cost: \$7 per student with teachers and chaperones attending at no cost. Minimum of \$140 per day required.

Other: Students must bring bag lunches. A soft drink vending machine is also available but can be turned off based on the schools individual restrictions. Restroom facilities are available, and staff are trained in first aid with first aid equipment on site. A dining hall with heating/air is available for meal time. Schools must sign a Hold-Harmless Agreement for the school and have students provide individual permission slips. The standard school permission slip is acceptable. (Provided by the BSA)

Adults: Adults can participate in the programs if they wish but it is not necessary.

Registration: To reserve a day, please complete the registration form and mail or fax to the Council office at least 2 weeks before the date you are reserving. If you would like to schedule a day that is less than 2 weeks away please call the number below for availability. Payment for all students must be provided when the group arrives at the Bonner Scout Reservation. You may bring additional students after you register but please call at least 24 hours prior to your arrival.
